

 - Resources to improve student learning
 - Data-informed decision making

School Development Plan – School Goal

 Task Design and assessment will improve student achievement in literacy.





School Development Plan – Outcome

- Students' written communication will improve through engagement in and with responsive feedback from rich literacy tasks.
- Student sense of safety and belonging will increase as teachers apply Social Emotional Learning with their task design.







School Development Plan – Outcome Measures

- Report card data ELAL (writing stem)
- CBE Student Survey Literacy
- English Language Arts Part A (writing) Grade 6
 Provincial Achievement test results







School Development Plan – Data for Monitoring Progress

- Formative assessment
- PLC sprint data writing instruction
- Professional Learning Communities common writing assessments





School Development Plan – Actions

- Learning Excellence:
 - Explicit use of mentor texts, graphic organizers and genre structures
 - Students will receive feedback that aligns with the learning intentions and success criteria for next steps for improvement
 - Build reciprocal reading-writing connections
 - Utilize loose parts and play based tools to improve and enhance oral language





School Development Plan – Actions

Well-Being:

- Create learning spaces that provide learners with a safe and respectful environment.
- Honour student voice and choice.
- Teachers will explicitly teach Social Emotional Learning to model and increase growth-mindsets in relation to writing.
- SEL integrated with academic instruction.





School Development Plan – Actions

- Truth & Reconciliation, Diversity and Inclusion:
 - Design students and staff learning tasks that intentionally activate the spirit, heart, body and mind.
 - Provide low floor, high ceiling tasks that create safe entry points into work.

Our School Budget

- Our school received almost 2.5 million in 2024-25 to provide a quality education to our students and meet the goals in our school development plan (SDP).
- At least 75 per cent of budgeted funds covers staffing and the remaining portion covers instructional and operational supplies.




